FBI Agents interviewed [] on 4/10/84 concerning his possible violation of Neutrality statutes. During this interview [] advised that he formed the CIVILIAN MILITARY ASSISTANCE (CMA) program in 1983 and claimed to have 16 - 20 "hard core" members he could count on to serve as military trainers for the governments of Honduras and El Salvador. He also claimed to have 200 other individuals who had volunteered their assistance as trainers, but he had not yet called on them.

[] advised that he had travelled to El Salvador in October, 1983 and met with officials at the U. S. Embassy who referred him to an El Salvador Army Officer. Several members had gained publicity when they detained some illegal aliens along the border and held them for U.S. authorities. [redacted]

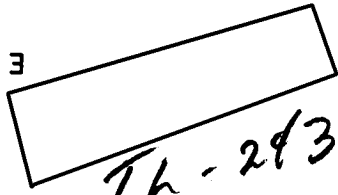

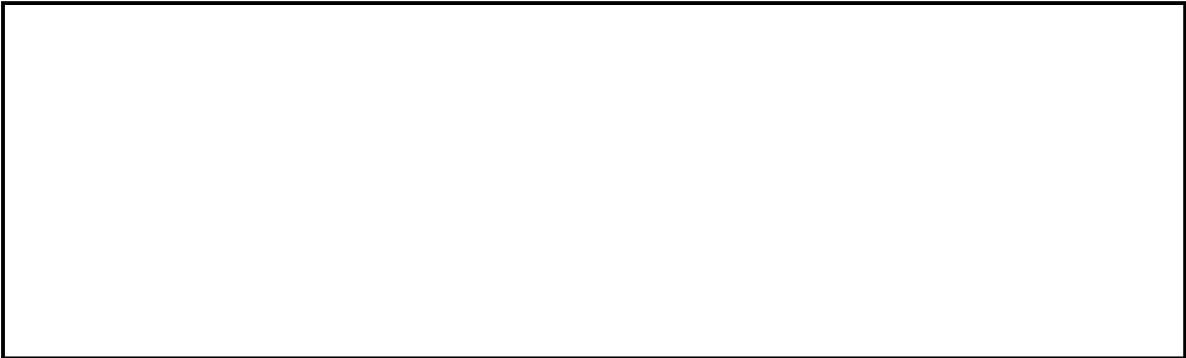
