# How to

# Install or Update

1

You'll need an iPod classic or iPod video running Rockbox to apply the theme.

Install Rockbox if you don't have it installed!

2

Plug in the iPod

Open it up in your computer's File Browser.

3, in the iPod's storage

On the computer, navigate to the **iPod's** .rockbox folder.

You might need to show hidden files to see this folder.


If you're on a Mac, hit [⌘⇧.] to toggle hidden files.

4, in your computer's storage

THIS folder you downloaded also contains a [.rockbox] folder.

Merge its contents into the [.rockbox] folder on the iPod, making sure to place the files in the right folders.

If updating, replace / delete any previous files or folders from older versions of this theme.



5

Eject and unplug the iPod once all files are in place.

6

On the iPod itself, boot into Rockbox.

Head to the theme settings to select the theme

or if updating to a new version of Infomatrix, re-select.

# Customise the UI Colours

## Customisation Settings

### Foreground Colour

Controls the colour of the lines and text.

### Line Selector → Primary Colour

Controls the background colour of the selector bar

### Line Selector → Text Color

Controls the text colour of the selected list item

### Background Colour

Controls the colour of the background if the background image is not displayed

### Line Selector → Secondary Colour

Only visible if you're using the gradient style line selector.  
Controls the second colour of the gradient.

### Line Separator Color

Controls the colour of the line separator if enabled.

## Line Selector Type

Adjust the style of the line selector.

Change the style of the line selector:

An arrow Cursor

Invert the Foreground Colour

Set Custom Colours (flat)

Set Custom Colours (gradient)

## Line Separator

Add a line between each list item

You can change the thickness with

Theme Settings

→ Line Separator

And it's colour with

Theme Settings

→ Colours

## Using the Color Picker



This is what you would use to select colours.

<< >> Choose R, G, or B to control

Scroll Adjust the selected colour

Menu Cancel

# Background Image

## Custom Background Requirements

Background images need to meet certain specifications in order to be able to be used as a theme background.

Must be the exact pixel dimensions of the screen

For the iPod Video and iPod Classic, background images need to be exactly 320 x 240px.

Must be BMP format

The image must be in the BMP format, not PNG or JPEG.

## Finding or creating a custom background

Your Infomatrix Plus pack comes with a few backgrounds I have made as a bonus.

They are all the correct size and format, ready to go. Unless you want your own background, continue below.

If you want to add your own background, you'll need to resize your image to 320 x 240px.

Use an image editor to resize the image to exactly 320 x 240px.

It may be easier to first crop the image to the 4:3 ratio, then resize it to 320 x 240px.

Finally, convert or export the image to BMP format.

You can try an online converter, but I've just been using photoshop.

## Applying the custom background

1  
Copy the background to the iPod, wherever

2  
Eject and unplug the iPod

3  
Navigate to your BMP image on the iPod

4  
Hold Centre to bring up the context menu.

4  
Hit "Set as Backdrop"

Not seeing "Set as backdrop"?  
The "Set as Backdrop" will only show if the backdrop image is the right spec. See above.

Reset  
Hit "Clear backdrop" in Theme Settings.
